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**MSDSL GENERAL MEETING MINUTES -JANUARY MEETING
JANUARY 2, 2001**

The MSDSL held its meeting at 7 pm on January 2, 2001, at the Florence Conference Center. Lisa Ruggles, President, called the meeting to order.

Roll: 60 present and 55 absent. 15 Provisionals present and 11 absent.

Minutes: Upon motion and a second, the December General meeting minutes were unanimously approved.

Treasurer: For Stephanie Winborn, President Lisa Ruggles reported the following balances:

Administrative:	9596.28
Community:	30893.56
Memorial:	215.10

Savings account balance = 290.96

Correspondence: Renee Vandiver indicated the League had received a thank you note from the Attention Homes for the monthly monetary contributions made by the League.

Committee Reports

Apple Annie: In the absence of Chairperson Penny Joiner, no report was made.

Bag-a-Bargain: Lari Collier made the following announcements: (1) the location for Bag-a-Bargain (BAB) has been changed to the Badcock Building due to the Royal Furniture location being leased by Steinmart; (2) a Quality Control/price list was distributed, explained, and will be placed on the MSDSL website; (3) Kick-Off Party theme has been determined - Lasso A Bargain, persons on this committee will be receiving a meeting notice followed by a telephone call; (4) corporate solicitation letters have been mailed and will be followed by telephone calls, the Corporate Solicitation Committee was asked to meet following the General Meeting; (5) a Drop-Off Scheduling for sale items was distributed; (6) the Quality Control committee voted to lower the minimum member donation from \$100 to \$75 per member and a \$3 pricing packet was made available to the first 100 members who purchased one - it contained pricing stickers, index cards, and safety pins; (7) clothing will not be accepted with pricing stickers; they must be labeled with index cards attached with safety pins; (8) prizes will be limited to the first 25 members who bring \$350 or more worth of merchandise, members who bring in \$350 worth of non-adult clothing merchandise will not be required to work a pricing shift but will work a sale shirt, members who bring in \$500 worth of non-adult clothing merchandise will not be required to work a pricing or a sale shift; (9) members who have not paid the \$30 for the Kick-Off Party were asked to submit that money immediately; (10) drop offs for sale items will be scheduled each Thursday from January 18 through February 22 from 4-8 p.m.; (11) Silent Auction Committee members will receive a notice about a January 22 meeting; (12) loading dock doors will be available at the rear of the Badcock Building for heavy items (furniture, etc.); (13) Scheduling Shifts are available at the rear of the room, any conflicts can be worked out if members will notify Leslie Tomlinson; (14) Lari Collier read a list of names of persons who were to meet next Tuesday at SunTrust Bank, 7th floor; (15) Services for donation for the Silent Auction are welcomed (e.g., 3-4 stay at a beach condo, legal services, hosting of a catered dinner, child's birthday party, etc.); (16) a limited number of items will be available to League members for purchase at the Silent Auction - those items will only be available at an announced time, there will be a limit that can be purchased, and they must be purchased at double the announced price; (17) there will be no general public admission charge to the Saturday sale; (18) members will be allowed to shop the sale at any time other than their scheduled sale schedule; and (19) talented members were asked to volunteer for the painting of the glass windows at the sale site.

Cookbook Chair: In the absence of Chairperson Allison Newton, no report was made.

Cookbook Treasurer: In the absence of Cookbook Treasurer Jackie Darby, no report was made.

Finance: Committee Chairs were asked to submit any budget changes to chairperson Becky McDaniel.

Future Policies: Katie Bendall asked that suggestions for Future Policy changes be provided to her as she will be meeting with her committee on January 15 at 5:30 p.m. at the Sheffield Public Library.

Hospitality: The Chairperson announced to the Hospitality Committee that she would be contacting them about providing snacks at the February meeting since the meeting will not be held at the Florence Conference Center.

Hourglass: Tonya Southall reported that the next deadline is January 15, 2001.

Placement: Chairperson Simone Mitchell asked all members to submit a Mid-Year Questionnaire to her before leaving the meeting or mail to her this week.

Public Relations: No report.

Provisional Directors: The next Provisional Meeting will be held on January 16 at the Kennedy-Douglass Center for the Arts.

Rehabilitation: In the absence of Chairperson Sabrina Eddins, no report was made.

Scholarship: No report.

Yearbook: Chairperson Monica Marthaler asked that members provide any address changes to her.

Transportation: One request was made during December. YTD \$1,176.70, balance \$323.30.

League Development: President-Elect Lisa Mathews asked everyone to consider sponsoring a member for consideration by the Admissions Committee for League membership.

Other Business: Next Board Meeting - February 6, 2001, 6:00 pm at the Badcock Building in Sheffield (Bag-a-Bargain site). Attention Homes donations for the January meeting totaled \$28.65.

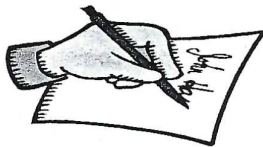

PROPOSED BY-LAW AND OPERATING RULES CHANGES

Changes are underlined

Proposed By-Laws

pg. 89- Section 3.

a. Number and County

Change one hundred seventy (170) to one hundred fifty (150)

b. Proposal of members. Leave out last sentence about "provided however, that no member of the Admissions committee may sponsor any candidate."

pg. 91

Article III

Dues

Add Section 3. Transfers. Any member shall be required to pay annual dues to the Muscle Shoals District Service League upon approval of transfer from a Junior League or other similar organizations.

pg. 93

Article IV

Board of Directors

Section 1. Number and Terms. Add Transportation/Attention Home to the Board

Proposed Operating Rules

I. Membership

pg. 103

Section 1. Membership Numbers.

A. Ratio. The very end of the sentence where it says "first county by more than ten" change "ten" to "twenty-five"

B. Add Number. "The number of invitations for membership will be determined by the number of available positions for each county plus an additional 33%. The resulting number should be rounded down. In the event that, after all acceptances and declines are counted, there is a total number greater than the total number of members, as specified in the Bylaws, the following year's invitations will reflect the overage."

This will compensate for rejections to membership and will allow the League to extend only one round of the invitations. "This is a statistically valid procedure based on the previous three years of admissions."

pg. 105 and 106.

Section 2. Admission

D. Transfer Members. The very end of the sentence on page 106 where it says "Service and fundraising requirements for that year". Add this statement: "Transfer members must pay Muscle Shoals District Service League Annual dues upon approval of her transfer."

pg. 116

II. Fundraising

Section 2-A. Officers

Make Office Coordinator and Membership Coordinator one job so it would be called Office/Membership Coordinator

Section IV. Fiscal Policies

Section 2.

Annual/Income Tax Return. After the sentence "and will make it available to any member upon request." Add the line, "The Muscle Shoals District Service League is an approved 501 (C) (3) organization. Because of this status, the league is required to file a 990 Income Tax return, no later than the 15th day of the 5th month following the League's Fiscal year ending on May 31st. The income tax return must be filed by October 15th."

Section 4. League Funds.

Replace all instances of the word "accounts" with the word "funds".

pg. 122-C. Community Fund.

Omit the words "follies funds".
