# Junior League of the Shoals Minutes

The Junior League of the Shoals held its April, 2009, meeting on April 7th, at the Shoals Conference Center. The meeting was called to order by Meredith McClanahan, President.

Minutes: A motion was made to accept the March Minutes. The motion was seconded and approved.

### Membership Status:

Leave Requests were approved for Heather McClure (Career) and Carol Beth Durbin (Maternity). Resignation requests were approved for Lisa Rogers, Sherrie Truitt, Danielle Hale, Paige Black, and Melissa Parks.

Treasurer's Report: Kerry Laughlin, Treasurer, presented the budged for approval. There were amendments as follows:

• Cookbook Expenses: The date for Actual Expenses was amended to read "2008-2009"; Projected taxes were changed to \$2000.00 from \$200.00, and Actual taxes were changed to \$1500.00 from \$150.00; Total Projected Expenses were \$3200.00, and Total Actual Expenses were \$27,123.73. 2009-2010 Projected Gross Profits were amended to \$8200.00; 2009 – 2010 Projected Net Profits were amended to \$5000.00.

Education & Seminars (including travel): 2008 – 2009 Actual was amended to \$3396.89 from \$4336.81. Kerry also reminded members that dues may be paid in installments over the summer. All dues checks should be sent to the P. O. Box and dated on or after June 1.

Guest Speaker: Corinne Reese, Executive Director of the Shoals Family Success Center spoke about the programs and opportunities of her organization.

Finance: Several community agencies were present at the meeting to receive Apple Annie and Sugar Plum grant checks.

**Done in a Day:** The League raised \$500 at the Texas Roadhouse event. These funds will be used to send children to the YMCA summer Camp.

**League Development:** President Elect Tonya Foote distributed surveys regarding the direction of the League for next year. Many positive responses were received. Membership forms deadline was April 10<sup>th</sup> at midnight.

Officer Elections: In an online vote, the following slate of officers was approved for 2009 - 2010: Tonya Foote, President; Jennifer Harscheid, President-Elect; Kerry Laughlin, Treasurer; Catherine Coker, Secretary.
