The MSDSL held its board meeting at 7 p.m. on September 3, 2002 at the First Presbyterian Church, Florence, AL. Allison Newton, President, called the meeting to order. Hard copy agendas were not distributed, to save paper and time, but an overhead of the meetings agenda was shown. 2002 Board was introduced, Leslie Tomlinson - President Elect, Lisa Eckl - Treasurer and Janice Pride - Recording Secretary.

**Roll:** 107 members present and 26 absent; 24 provisionals present and 2 absent.

**Minutes:** Upon motion by Tonya Southall and a second by Becky McDaniel, the minutes from the September meeting were approved unanimously.

**Treasurer:** Lisa Eckl reported the following balances:

Administrative:	\$ 3,072.38
Community:	9,307.57
Memorial:	215.10
Checking Account Balance:	\$12,595.05

She reminded members that \$55.00 league dues are due November 15, 2002. Lisa also reminded membership that they would not receive the black book until dues were received.

**Correspondence:** Tonya Southall introduced herself to the league and described the duties of Correspondence Secretary, which is to conduct the general correspondence for the League.

**Committee Reports:**

**Apple Annie:** Chairperson Mary Marshall Van Sant circulated Apple Annie handout. Apple Annie committee was announced. She stated that members should NOT call a business unless the crate chairs are informed about the call and that each member and provisional would be responsible for selling 20 bags. There will be a checkout this year again, no check-in at polishing party. You will need to contact the Town Chairs by email towards the end of October, watch Hourglass for details. The Provisional class will be contacted separately. The Apple Annie office will be at Woodward Avenue Baptist Church and all money will be due no later than Apple Annie Day.

**Bag A Bargain:** Lynne Bevis and Michelle Simpson - the chairs handed out an information sheet on BAB and all committee are to meet for a few minutes at the end of general meeting tonight to discuss responsibilities. Dates are sale March 8th and Preview Party March 7th. Scheduling cards will be handed out next meeting "first come first serve basis". Steinmart will participate in BAB by offering 2 days in February to bring in merchandise for BAB and receive a Steinmart coupon.

**Cookbook Chair:** Chairperson Lori Dolan reported that we have two recipes published in a Southern Living Cookbook. She also will have books at the meetings if you need any.

**Cookbook Treasurer:** No Report.

**Finance:** Chairperson Linda Isbell informed us that we are in contact with over 60 local agencies that can request funds from MSDSL. Linda requested that members give her names and numbers of agencies interested in Apple Annie funds.

**Future Policies:** Chairperson Amy Jon Finch requested that members inform her of any interest in policy changes. She explained to the provisionals about the "black book" and to call her if you have any questions or suggestions.

**Hospitality:** Chairperson Amy Jon Finch thanked First Presbyterian for opening up their facilities to us for free and also thanked Robin Coussons for her effort in obtaining the building.

**Hourglass:** Kelly McCormack reported that the next deadline is September 13, 2002.

**Placement:** Chairperson Susie Ray introduced the Placement advisors and informed us that summer placement hour reports are due and that September placement agencies should be contacted.

**Public Relations:** Chairperson Becky McDaniel informed membership to contact her if you needed an Apple Annie shirt. She will be placing an order soon.

**Provisional Directors:** Chairpersons Ashli Smith and Kristi Sockwell reported that the next provisional meeting would be on September 17, 2002, at the new Westway Development Center. They thanked Patty Klos and Lisa Davis for opening up their homes this summer for Provisional functions. Kristi will take orders for red tights.

**Rehabilitation:** No Report

**Scholarship:** Janice Pride announced that Bobby Atkinson, last year's recipient has been awarded the scholarship. He is a senior at UNA.

**Yearbook:** Karen Christian said that yearbooks will be available at the October meeting upon payment of dues.

**Transportation:** Lucy Cook will be accepting donations of products, such as shampoo, lotions, etc., for the Attention home. A box will be in the back of the meeting room in October for these items.

**League Development:** President-Elect Leslie Tomlinson reported that she is responsible for League morale and would like to do something special for League members who do "extra" things for our community on behalf of the league. Please inform her if you know someone who deserves a "Happy".

**Next Meeting** will be Tuesday, October 1, 2002, at First Presbyterian Church, Florence. With no further business, Allison Newton adjourned the meeting.

### Post sign up:

2. Members approved to miss polishing party must sign up for an extra 2-hour post, either on the street or in the office. Exception: If you are missing both polishing party and Apple Annie Day, the overall chairman with the executive boards approval must excuse you and you will be required to make up the time with extra Apple Annie work and have someone work your post.

2. All members must call in their sales, even the required 20 bags. If you sell crates, you must also call them into the bag chairs. In your phone call, please specify to whom you sold the crate or half crate. The only exception to this is if you have called the crate chair and told her and she said she would call it in. Don't forget, you can even call in your pre-sales early!!!!
3. Dummy sheets may be picked up at the October meeting.

If you cannot be at Polishing Party, the overall chairman must approve your absences, and it is **YOUR** responsibility to have someone pick up your apples (bags and crates)!!!!

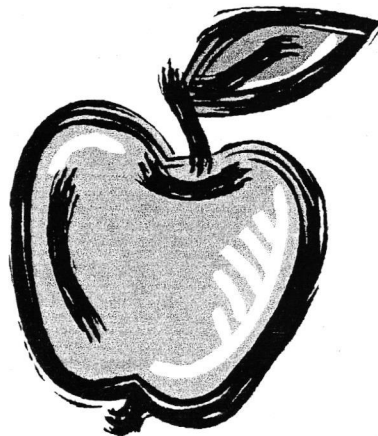

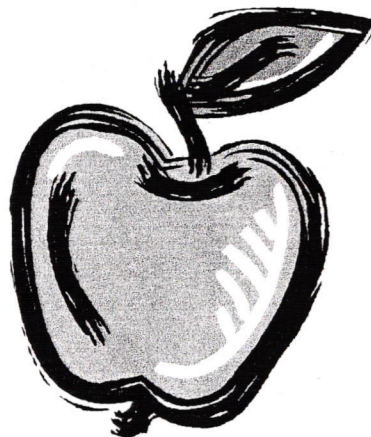
